**Subject: -Grant of Conditional Permission to Karamvir Vyankatrao Tanaji Randhir Ayurved College, At-Post-Boradi, Tal-Shirpur, Dist. Dhule-425428, Maharashtra (Inst. ID. AYU0145) with 60 seats (75 seats including EWS) in UG (BAMS) course for the academic session 2024-25 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder-reg.**

Sir/Madam,

With reference to the subject mentioned above, I am directed to inform you that in pursuance of the provision of National commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020, the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) has been repealed with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021. With effect from the said date, the Central Council of Indian Medicine constituted under sub-division (1) of section 3 of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) shall stand dissolved. Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (3) of the section 1 of the said Act, the Central Government hereby notifies that all the provisions of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020 has been come into force with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021 and as per regulation 59 (2) of The National Commission for Indian System of Medicine ACT, 2020, Medical standards, requirements and other provisions of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 and the rules and regulations made there under shall continue to be in force and operate till new standards or requirements are specified under this Act or the rules and regulations made there under.

1. Further, to assess the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, Hospital staff, practical training and other infrastructure facilities at your college namely **Karamvir Vyankatrao Tanaji Randhir Ayurved College, At-Post-Boradi, Tal-Shirpur, Dist. Dhule-425428, Maharashtra (Inst. ID. AYU0145)** inspection of your College was conducted on **15.02.2024 & 16.02.2024 on Hybrid mode** as a part of annual visitation by the visitation team of Medical Assessment and rating Board, NCISM to process the **conditional permission with 60 seats (75 seats including EWS) in UG (BAMS) course under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2024-25.**

Further, the visitation report and all other related documents were assessed in terms of the enforced regulations namely the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016", provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations there under. **Careful examination of the assessment report following shortcoming/defect have been observed-**

a) Availability of teaching staff is  $\frac{\text{Available}}{\text{Required}} \times 100\% = \frac{29}{30} \times 100\% = 96.6\%$  which is not fulfilling the criteria as per Sub Regulation (1) (a) of Regulation 8 and Schedule-V of MSR 2016.

b) Shortcoming is as under-

As per the direction of President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM), assessment report was placed in the **82<sup>nd</sup> Board meeting** of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) held on **08.03.2024** and Board concluded that the college is not fulfilling the notified approved criteria, but fulfilling the criteria required for issuance of permission as per the Regulation 3 of MSR 2016 and as per the note mentioned in Schedule-V of MSR 2016. Hence, Board decided to issue conditional permission with 60 seats (75 seats including EWS) in UG (BAMS) course under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2024-25.

Therefore, conditional permission is issued to Karamvir Vyankatrao Tanaji Randhir Ayurved College, At-Post-Boradi, Tal-Shirpur, Dist. Dhule-425428, Maharashtra (Inst. ID. AYU0145) in UG (BAMS) course under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2024-25.
