With effect from the said date, the Central Council of Indian Medicine constituted under sub-division (1) of section 3 of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) shall stand dissolved. Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (3) of the section 1 of the said Act, the Central Government hereby notifies that all the provisions of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020 has been come into force with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021 and as per regulation 59 (2) of The National Commission for Indian System of Medicine ACT, 2020, Medical standards, requirements and other provisions of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 and the rules and regulations made there under shall continue to be in force and operate till new standards or requirements are specified under this Act or the rules and regulations made there under.

Further, to assess the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, Hospital staff, practical training and other infrastructure facilities at your college namely Karamvir Vyankatrao Tanaji Randhir Ayurved College, At-Post-Boradi, Tal-Shirpur, Dist. Dhule-425428, Maharashtra (Inst. ID. AYU0145) inspection of your College was conducted on 15.02.2024 & 16.02.2024 on Hybrid mode as a part of annual visitation by the visitation team of Medical Assessment and rating Board, NCISM to process the conditional permission with 60 seats (75 seats including EWS) in UG (BAMS) course under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2024-25.
